Proposition 84

Emergency Grants:

- Public Resources Code Section 75021
 - \$10 million originally allocated ~
 - Approximately < \$600K remaining in Part 2

Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF)

Expedited Emergency Application Process:

As described in the 2013 Intended Use Plan (IUP), Section K:

- Public Water Systems (PWS) experiencing an emergency event can now immediately submit a universal pre-application allowing for CDPH to immediately rank the project and adopt it to the Project Priority List (PPL)
- PWS will be automatically invited to submit a full application for funding
- Emergency Projects determined to be caused by drought are currently exempt from CEQA (all other requirements apply)

COOPERATIVE EFFORTS

CDPH/USDA:

- CDPH and USDA are jointly working with drought affected Public Water
 Systems that meet eligibility requirements
 - Goals:
 - Effectively provide funding to those most in need
 - Jointly fund projects that may exceed funding program caps

CDPH/JEOC:

- CDPH maintains ongoing communication with the Joint Emergency
 Operations Center
 - Goals:
 - Ensure and direct available resources
 - Report the status of at risk public water systems
 - Report funding efforts
